# **SUNDAY SCHOOL**




Our Sunday School classrooms are nicely decorated, the kids' photos are on the wall and each student has a binder for their work and handouts.

#### Stewardship Report

Thanks to the efforts of many parishioners, there has been great progress at Holy Trinity this past year. Several areas - inside and out - have been cleared, cleaned, organized and beautified! We have offered hospitality throughout our events and through our Sunday fellowship coffee hour. With generous donations of time and funds, our Philoptochos impacted the community at large, our youth ministries, and the church facility. We've also had an active year for our youth, with a reinvigorated Sunday School program and an active GOYA chapter.

The only area that has not met expectations is the amount contributed to the basic operating expenses of our parish, which all come from designated stewardship donations. Please look into your hearts and end the year with a final 2024 stewardship donation commensurate with the needs of our parish.

The Stewardship theme for 2025 is "Your Own from Your Own" from the Divine Liturgy. God receives our humble offering of bread and wine and returns those to us as His Body and Blood in Holy Communion. As Orthodox Christians, we see the world as God's gift, a sacrament of God's presence, and a means of communion with Him. This way we are able to offer back to God, in thanksgiving and love, the many gifts we receive from Him.

In the miracle of the five loaves and two fish, we are taught to offer what we have, no matter the amount, and miracles will happen.

So it is with our church, as we often imagine only what is humanly possible. If we do our part in faith, God will lovingly return to us much more than we could ever imagine. This is the true meaning of "Your own from your own". We will see our church not as it is, but as it could be, with our humble gifts multiplied by God's generosity and love.





#### KOLIVA FOR MEMORIAL SERVICES:

Koliva is used for commemorations of the departed (40<sup>th</sup> day after death; 3<sup>rd</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup> month, annually) and Saturdays of the Souls. Contact Faye Peterson, <u>pete9839@comcast.net</u> or Angela Lekos, <u>angelmou1@att.net</u> if you need Koliva prepared. There is a fee of \$100 for materials, supplies and labor.

**ARTOKLASIA:** Blessing of the Five Loaves is a service of thanksgiving through which we express our gratitude for all the blessings of life. The Blessing is offered on a feast day or special occasion. If you need Artoklasia prepared, contact Angel Lekos, <u>angelmou1@att.net</u>.

#### HOUSE BLESSINGS:

To arrange for a "house blessing" please contact the priest to make an appointment.

**MEMORIAL**: To request a gravesite memorial, please contact the priest.

**SPECIAL SERVICE:** If you have a request for a special memorial service (traditionally a volunteered donation is given to the priest), please contact the church office in advance of the requested date with details.

To offer Holy Communion to someone in need at a hospital, nursing home, in hospice care or at home, please contact the priest
