Maria Lagoutaris has accepted our nomination to join the council. We need at least one more member, and we humbly request all parish stewards to come forward to join the PC, fill the final role, and help us do the church's business. Thank you to the previous council members who gave their time, talents, and treasure to serve us these past two years. Under their leadership and with the support of many volunteers and donors, we have held meaningful spiritual, liturgical, and sacramental events, our parish facilities are mostly repaired and beautiful, and we have had successful cultural events and much more. I want to share the vision and number 1 priority I shared with the PC in our first meeting last Tuesday, January 21. That vision is to grow our church. Gary Peterson is starting a committee to work on this priority. I challenged each PC member to work for this committee in addition to their other responsibilities. Work has started and we ask that each of you pray for us, reach

out to people and bring them to church, and give us any ideas that you have that will move this priority forward.

A Personal Reflection on Stewardship

Stewardship is a concept that resonates deeply with me. It is more than just a responsibility or a duty: it is a guiding principle that shapes my actions, decisions, and interactions with the world around me. The words from the liturgy resonate in my head as the priest says: μεταλαμβάνει ο **δούλος** του Θέου Σώμα και αίμα Χριστού είς Αφεσιν αμαρτιών Και ζωήν αιωνίων. That is: The servant of God receives the body and blood of Christ for the remission of sins and life eternal. That's who I want to be, the servant of God. My stewardship role is that of a servant. It means I use my time, talents, and treasures to serve my family, church, and community.

How do people know I am a servant, a steward, a caretaker of God's promise? It is sometimes difficult to see out in the community, but in the church, it is as simple as looking at the stewardship list. Filling out a stewardship card is a simple task in and of itself. But this action enables your parish council to communicate with you, create a budget, and measure our efforts to serve the church. I pray you make it the next act of your stewardship.

Contact Faye Peterson, pete9839@comcast.net or Angela Lekos, angelmou1@att.net if you need Koliva prepared. There is a fee of \$100 for materials, supplies and labor. **ARTOKLASIA:** Blessing of the Five Loaves is a service of thanksgiving through which we express our gratitude for all the blessings of life. The Blessing is offered on a feast day or special occasion. If you need Artoklasia prepared, contact Angela Lekos, angelmou1@att.net. **HOUSE BLESSINGS:** To arrange for a "house blessing" please contact the priest to make an appointment. **MEMORIAL:** To request a gravesite memorial, please contact the priest. **SPECIAL SERVICE:** If you have a request for a special memorial service (traditionally a volunteered donation is given to the priest), please contact the church office in advance of the requested date with details. To offer Holy Communion to someone in need at a hospital, nursing home, in hospice care or at home, please contact the priest. **The deadline for the weekly Church bulletin e-mail articles is before noon on Wednesday. The deadline for the monthly Newsletter articles is the 25th of the month.
